

Nick Sharratt, Children's Author

Presenter's Biography :

Nick Sharratt is a British illustrator and author of children's books, whose work is split between illustrating for writers, most notably Jacqueline Wilson and Jeremy Strong, but also Giles Andreae, Julia Donaldson and Michael Rosen. He was chosen to be the official illustrator for World Book Day 2006, and has illustrated around 250 books, including over 50 books by Wilson. The books on which Sharratt and Wilson have collaborated have sold more than 40 million copies in the UK and sales of picture books illustrated by Nick exceed 10 million.

Nick illustrates for children's authors as well as producing his own picture books for a younger audience. His books include Shark in the Park, Ketchup on your Cornflakes?, What's In the Witch's Kitchen?, Don't Put Your Finger in the Jelly, Nelly!, Octopus Socktopus and My Mum and Dad make Me Laugh.

Summary of Presentation :

In his session Nick will be hosting a drawalong, focusing on his favourite picture books, many of which revolve around the subject of food. The audience will sketch along with him, as he shows how he goes about drawing all sorts of funny characters. He will be encouraging creative thinking and suggesting how the pictures could be taken further outside the confines of the session.

Each participating child will require basic drawing materials, at least 8 sheets of paper (A4 is ideal) and something to rest on if not sitting at a table.
